BRONZE MEDALLION

Includes resuscitation, basic first aid, rescue techniques, surf skills, teamwork and communication. You need to be able to swim 400m in 9 minutes (in a pool) so now is the time to get some training going.

ADVANCED RESUS TECHNIQUES

Includes oxygen resuscitation, airway management and defibrillation. *We need many more patrol members with this qualification and are looking to run some courses ASAP...*

SPINAL MANAGEMENT

Again, we need many more patrol members with this qualification and are looking to run some courses ASAP...

SENIOR FIRST AID COURSE

If you would like to gain or renew your Senior First Aid Qualification, SLSSA are running courses at their new facility at West Beach on these dates:

Saturday 8th September Tuesday 18th September
Tuesday 23rd October Saturday 10th November
Monday 19th November Saturday 8th December

You need to complete a workbook prior to the course so the sooner you register the more time you will have to complete it!
